# Access to the Grand Colombier from Culoz

From Saturday 8 to Friday 14 July

## FOR LIGHT VEHICLES

- The car park for light vehicles located at the «Fenestrez» (accessible from Culoz and Anglefort) will be accessible until Friday, July 14 at 10 a.m. (subject to availability).
- The summit of the Col du Grand Colombier will remain accessible to light vehicles up to Thursday July 13 at 8 a.m., but without the possibility of parking on the road.
- Parking outside official car parks will not be allowed on the roadway RD120 and 120A from July 8 at 8 a.m.
- Traffic will be closed on the road RD120 from the roundabout on top of Culoz town on July 14 at 6 a.m. and on the RD 120A-120 above Anglefort on July 14 at 10 a.m.
- The roads will only be open in the evening (approximately 9:30 p.m.).

### On the evening of Thursday July 13

- Closure of Avenue Jean Falconnier in Culoz. Crossing Culoz will remain possible by rue de Luyrieux and rue du Rhône until the publicity caravan. (at 3:04 p.m.)

### On the 14th of July

- Light vehicles can park at the level of the Rhône river embankment (subject to availability).

### For cyclists

- The roads of the Col du Grand Colombier will be accessible by bike up to 1 hour before the caravan announced at 3:04 p.m. in Culoz.
- As car parks are limited in Culoz, it is recommended for cyclists wishing to approach the Grand Colombier by car to park in the surrounding villages.

## FOR MOTORHOMES

- Access to the summit of the Col du Grand Colombier is prohibited for motorhomes.
- Opening of the motorhome parking lot located at a few kilometers from the summit in «La Frappe» (subject to availability).
- Parking outside official motorhomes parks will not be allowed on the roads RD120 and 120A from July 8 at 8 a.m.
- Traffic will be closed on the road RD120 (above the last roundabout on the top of Culoz town) on July 14 at 6 a.m. and on the road RD120A-120 from Anglefort on July 14 at 10 a.m.
- The roads will only be open in the evening (approximately 9:30 p.m.).

## IN PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Access to Culoz can be done by train, located on the Lyon-Geneva railway line, Culoz railway station Culoz is 600 meters away from the stage at the foot of the last climb.



# Access to the Grand Colombier from Arvière-en-Valromey

From Saturday 8 to Friday 14 July

## FOR LIGHT VEHICLES

- The light vehicle parking lot located at Granges du Grand Colombier will be accessible until Friday, July 14 at 10 a.m. (subject to availability).
- The summit of the Col du Grand Colombier will remain accessible to light vehicles up to Thursday July 13 at 8 a.m., without the possibility of parking on the road.
- Parking outside official car parks will not be permitted on the roadway RD120 from Lochieu from July 8 at 8 a.m.
- Traffic on the road RD120 will be closed from Lochieu on July 14 at 6 a.m.
- Traffic will only be open towards the top only in the evening (approximately 9:30 p.m.).

## FOR MOTORHOMES

- Access to the summit of the Col du Grand Colombier is prohibited for motorhomes.
- Opening of the motorhome parking lot located at a few kilometers from the summit at Selle de Fromentelle (subject to availability).
- Parking outside official car parks will not be permitted on the roadway RD120 from Lochieu from July 8 at 8 a.m.
- Traffic will be closed on the RD120 from Lochieu on July 14 at 6 a.m.
- Traffic will only be open towards the top only in the evening (approximately 9:30 p.m.).

## Access to the Grand Colombier for hikers

- **From Culoz:** access to the first part of the ascent by following the main road, access to the second part by following the GR9 trail .
- **From Sur Lyand or La Combe du Cimetière** (col de la Biche) following the GR9 trail or the local hikes (about 7 km one way).
- **Very sporty access** possible from Lochieu, Virieu-le-Petit, Chavornay and Béon (elevation gain of nearly 1,000m and limited car parks on sites)





## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

As the Tour should remain a merry celebration for all, please respect the following rules:

- Please keep dogs on a leash.
- Drink responsibly.
- Do not leave your children unattended.
- Do not spray with water, touch or run next to riders.
- Smoke bombs, drones, banners crossing the roadway, water jets are prohibited.
- Watch out for fires (cigarette, BBQ).
